

Disciple Crossing Camps:

Family Camp 1: (May 25-27 & August 10-12) – for ages 0 to 18 who are accompanied by an adult chaperone (21 years of age or older)

Grand Camp: (June 1-3) – for ages 4 to 10 who are accompanied by one or more of their grandparents.

Adventure Camp: (June 4-9) —for grades 6 through 12. Camp begins at 10:00 am on Monday and ends at 10:00 am on Saturday. Drop off and pick up will be arranged at Disciples Crossing's main camp.

Discovery Camp: (June 8-10) – for grades 1 and 2. Discovery campers attend with one or both parents and/or their primary guardian. Grandparents who would like to take grandkids to camp should plan to attend Grand Camp or Family Camp.

Chi Rho: (June 11-16 and July 16-21) – for grades 6 and 7. Chi Rho Camp is one of the most unique and memorable experiences of all our summer camps. The week is filled with silly large group games, small groups where we practice talking about our faith, worship experiences and great keynotes.

CYF Conference: (June 18 – 23) – for grades 10 through 12. CYF Conference is at the Main Camp. **(Evan is attending.)**

Niners: (June 18-23) – Grade 9 (Niners) focuses on leadership development and spirituality. Campers are taught ways to strengthen their faith practices and how to use their gifts and talents to serve God. Niners is held at the Creative Camp.

Eighters Youth Conference: (June 24 – 30) – Grade 8 AKA "Created to be Me" Camp Eighters is designed to teach campers about spirituality and sexuality through a wonderful Christian curriculum. Parents will receive detailed information about each day's topic and theme after they enroll their camper in the session.
